1 SEC. 2. PURPOSE.

2 The purpose of this Act is to level the playing field
3 for service providers participating in the Rural Digital Op4 portunity Fund that are disadvantaged by short construc5 tion seasons.

6 SEC. 3. APPLICATION PROCESSING PRIORITIZATION.

7 With respect to the long-form applicants of the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Phase II auction provided for 8 9 in the Report and Order in the matter of Rural Digital Opportunity Fund and Connect America Fund adopted by 10 the Federal Communications Commission (in this section 11 referred to as the "Commission") on January 30, 2020 12 (FCC 20–5), the Commission shall prioritize the timely 13 processing of long-form applications and any subsequent 14 paperwork (in this section referred to as the "applica-15 tions") submitted by the long-form applicants as follows: 16 17 The Commission shall prioritize the timely processing of applications which are proposing to provide service in geo-18 19 graphic areas which the Commission determines to have 20 the shortest construction seasons (such as in areas characterized by long winters with heavy snowfall). 21
